Accused A-1 Tr.C.Muthunathan was an elected Panchayat President of Pachampalayam Panchayat, Anthiyur Union & Taluk, Erode District and he was holding the post from 25.10.11 to 24.10.2016. Now he is a Private Individual, as his tenure expired on 24.10.2016.

Accused A-2 Tr.S.Kesavan is working as Panchayat Secretary, Pachampalayam Panchayat, Anthiyur Union & Taluk, Erode District from 27.1.1999 to till date.

Accused A-3 Tr.W.Thomas Rajan was working as Block Development Officer(Village Panchayat), Panchayat Union, Anthiyur Union & Taluk, Erode District from 26.7.2013 to 02.10.2015. Now working as Assistant Director, Accounts and Admin, Mahalir Thittam, Trippur District from 21.3.2018 to till date.

Accused A-4 Tmt.Sathya, W/o Gunasekaran, Door No.11/64, Ganapathi Kattur, Pachampalayam (PO), Anthiyur (TK), Erode District is a private individual.

Accused A-5 Tmt.S.Murugambal, W/o.K.Shanmugam, Door No.282, Bhavani Road, State Bank of India (Opposite), Pachampalayam, Anthiyur (TK), Erode District is a private individual.

Accused A-1 to A-3 are public servants as defined u/s 2 (c) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. A-4 & A-5 are beneficiaries under IAY Scheme during 2014-15.

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It was revealed that the Indira Awaas Yojana (herein after referred to as IAY Scheme) is a Housing Scheme launched by the Central Government, under the Ministry of Rural Development, to provide houses to the poor in rural areas. The objective of the scheme is to help the poor in construction/ up gradation of dwelling units, by providing them a lump sum financial assistance.

The Govt. of India, issues guidelines to the IAY Scheme every year in respect of cost for construction of house and others. Likewise, during June-2013, Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development issued guidelines for implementation of this Scheme and the same was applicable for the execution of the Scheme during the financial year 2014-2015.

The Scheme is implemented through the District Rural Development Agencies (DRDA) and houses are constructed by the beneficiaries themselves. The beneficiaries have complete freedom as to the manner of construction. The DRDA can help the beneficiaries in acquiring raw material. Thus, the responsibility for the proper construction of the house lies on the beneficiaries themselves.

The selection of beneficiaries is made by the Grama Sabha based on the Below Poverty Line (BPL) list maintained by the Village Panchayat concerned. The beneficiaries are provided funds by the DRDA on staggered basis, depending on the progress of house construction work, as decided by the State Government or at the district level. The funds should be transferred directly in to the beneficiaries accounts in a bank or Post office.

Allotment of the IAY house shall be jointly in the name of husband and wife except in the case of a widow/unmarried/separated person. The State may also choose to allot it solely in the name of the woman. In the case of beneficiaries selected under the quota for persons with disabilities, the allotment should be only to such persons. The allotment order should be in a form which may be prescribed by the State conferring the title to the house. In the case of house sites, the land identification may be assigned in the name of the eldest woman of the household except in the case of all

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male households and pucca title granted as Patta and house for the assignee of the land should also be allotted to that person.

Based on the said guidelines, the District Collector, Erode has issued administrative sanction to all Panchayat Presidents through the concerned Block Development Officers (Village Panchayats) to select beneficiaries and construct the houses under the Scheme vide Na.Ka.No.143/2014/A10, Dated.14.2.14. Specific instructions were also given in the said order along with IAY guidelines.

In the said order, it was specifically instructed that the selected beneficiary and the Panchayat President have to give certificate that none of the family members of the beneficiary was benefitted under this Scheme early and none of the family members is in government job. The certificate has to be signed by the concerned BDO(VP) also.

Accused A-1 to A-3 has the responsibility of selecting eligible beneficiaries under this Scheme during the financial year 2014-15 through Grama Sabha meeting, Pachampalayam. Accused A-1 and A-2 has the responsibility of sending the list of beneficiaries selected in the Grama Sabha, to the BDO Office, for getting work order and issuing of Cheques to the eligible beneficiaries, after getting fund release order from the BDO office etc., Accused A-1 and A-3 also has the specific responsibility of giving certificate that none of the family members of the beneficiary (including beneficiaries A-4 and A-5) was benefitted under this Scheme early. Similarly, accused/beneficiaries A-4 and A-5 has the responsibility of giving certificate that none of their family members were benefitted under this Scheme early.

By violating the norms and guidelines stated above and ignoring the responsibilities given to all the accused,

i) Accused 1 to 3 entered in to criminal conspiracy with Accused A-4 Tmt.Sathya, W/o Gunasekaran, Ganapathykattur, during the implementation of Indira Awaas Yojana Scheme (Housing Scheme) in the year 2014-2015 at Pachampalayam Panchayat, Anthiyur Union and knowingly selected Accused A-4 as if she was

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an eligible beneficiary, under the Scheme, by framing incorrect document, even though the beneficiary was ineligible and already benefitted under Chief Minister's Solar Powered Green House Scheme during 2012-13. Subsequent to this selection, the beneficiary abetted Accused A-1 to A-3 for payment and got benefit worth Rs 1,20,000/- under the Scheme for house construction and thereby Accused A-1 to A-4 caused loss to the government to the tune of Rs.1,20,000/- during 2014, by Cheating the government and the Accused A-1 to A-3 derived undue pecuniary advantage from the beneficiary by facilitating government subsidy amount of Rs 1,20,000/- for house construction 2nd time.

ii) Accused A-1 to A-3 entered in to criminal conspiracy with Accused A-5 Tr.Shanmugam, Tmt.Murugambal, W/o Annamaduvu, during the implementation of Indira Awaas Yojana Scheme (Housing Scheme) in the year 2014-2015 at Pachampalayam Panchayat, Anthiyur Union and knowingly selected Accused A-5 as if she was an eligible beneficiary, under the Scheme, by framing incorrect document, even though the beneficiary was ineligible and her husband Tr.Shanmugam was already benefitted under Chief Minister's Solar Powered Green House Scheme during 2011-12. Subsequent to this selection, the beneficiary abetted Accused A-1 to A-3 for payment and got benefit worth Rs 1,20,000/- under the Scheme for house construction and thereby Accused A-1 to A-3 & A-5 caused loss to the government to the tune of Rs.1,20,000/-, during 2014, by Cheating the government and the Accused A-1 to A-3 derived undue pecuniary advantage from the beneficiary by facilitating government subsidy amount of Rs 1,20,000/- for house construction 2nd time.

There is prima facie cognizable offence made out against the accused A1 to A5 that the accused committed the offences punishable u/s 120-B, 420, 167, 109 IPC and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Hence, a case in Erode V& AC Cr.No. 02/AC/2020 u/s 120-B, 420, 167, 109 IPC and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 is registered.

Original FIR will be submitted to the Hon'ble Special Judge and Chief Judicial Magistrate, Erode and a copy of FIR will be submitted to the Director, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai, for information.
