Based on credible information collected by an officer of the Vigilance and Anti-Corruption Department through source it is learnt that A-1 to A-4, who are public servants u/s 2(c) of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018 colluding with each other committed malpractices by preparing applications other than in the names of the applicants abused their official duties and obtained wrongful gain up to extent of Rs. 2,24,400/- in Amma cement supply scheme and the verification revealed the following facts.

It is revealed that A-1 Tr.C.Alagappan is working as Overseer, Panchayat Union Office, Arimalam, Pudukkottai District from 10.06.2008, A-2 Tr.R.Elangovan is working as Overseer, Panchayat Union Office, Arimalam, Pudukkottai District from 02.08.2010,

FIR read over to the Complainant / Informant, admitted to be correctly recorded and a copy given to the Complainant / Informant free of cost.

A-3 Tr.C.Vellaisamy, Overseer, Panchayat Union Office, Arimalam, Pudukkottai District from 10.06.2008 and A-4 Tr.C.Lakshmanan was formerly working as Deputy Block Development Officer, Pudukkottai and retired from service on 31.07.2016. As per the Proceedings of the BDO, Arimalam he was re appointed as Godown Incharge of Amma cement supply Godown, Arimalam Panchayat Union and he has been working there from 01.06.2017. A-1 to A-4 are Public servants as defined u/s 2(c) of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act 2018 during the period of occurrence.

It is revealed that the price of cement in Tamilnadu has been consistently high owing to various factors causing hardship to general public particularly lower and middle income groups. The Government has been exploring various options to lessen the cement price so as to safe guard the interest of this lower and middle income groups as the price in the open market is high. So, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamilnadu announced on 26.09.2014 that Amma cement supply scheme, implemented for providing cement at a concessional rate of Rs.190/- per bag.

It is revealed that consequently the Managing Director Tamilnadu Cements Corporation Ltd. (TANCEM) has sent a detailed proposal involving Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department and Tamil Nadu Civil Supply Corporation towards implementation of the Amma cement supply scheme. In this regard the Government issued order in G.O (MS) No.188 Industries (MID.2) Department dated 11.12.2014.

Houses constructed under the Chief Minister Solar Powered Green House scheme and Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) shall also avail the benefit under this Amma cement supply scheme. It is further revealed that the cost of cement would be collected by the Godown in-charge from the consumer in advance @ Rs.190/- per bag inclusive of all in the form of account payee demand draft drawn in favour of Tamilnadu Cements Corporation Limited, Chennai from any Nationalized/ Scheduled Banks. The consumer shall also be permitted to pay cash for the purchase of value of cement up to Rs.19,000/-.

In respect of Arimalam Union, Pudukkottai District, the following malpractices were noticed in the implementation of the Amma cement supply scheme. Actually in the register maintained for the issuance of cement from Arimalam Union to 18 persons in Thirumayam Taluk, Pudukkottai District are 1) Tr.Sankaran, S/o.Karuppan, Arimalam, 2) Tr.Pitchai Muthu, S/o.Ramaiah, Onankudi, 3) Tr.Karuppaiah, S/o. Adaikkan, Mirattunilai, 4) Tr. Muthu, S/o. Karuppan, No.143, South Tmt.Lakshmi, W/o.Chokkalingam, Vettukkadu. Ponthupuli, 5) Tmt. Marikannu, W/o.Karuppaiah, No. 288, Valaiayampatti, 7) Tmt.Sasikala, W/o.Pandiarajan, No.203, Kamman chetti chatthiram, Tmt.Mumthaj Bhegam, W/o.Saleem, No.202, Kamman chetti chatthiram, 9) Tmt.Karupayee, W/o.Chithambaram, Elankudipatti, 10) Tmt. Veerayee, W/o. Ulagappan, No. 2/16, Melnelaipatti, Tmt.Renganayaki, W/o. Sethuraman, Kallur, 12) Tmt.Tamilarasi, W/o. Soundarapandian, Kallur, 13) Tmt. Arokiyamery, W/o. Yacob, Kallur, 14) Tmt.Tamilselvi, W/o.Ramaiah, Rayavaram, 15) Tmt.Karpagam, W/o. Shanmugam, Kallur, 16) Tmt. Karupayee, W/c. Kuthan, Thuraiyur, Keelanilai, 17) Tmt.Eswari, W/o.Kuppusamy, Thuraiyur 18) Tmt.Adakki, W/o.Karuppaiah, Thuraiyur are shown as receiving 3,740 cement bags. But on the confidential enquiry it is evident that those 18 persons did not apply and purchased the cement as mentioned in the register and they also disowned the signatures found in the applications.

A-1 to A-4 colluded with each other, committed malpractices, prepared the applications in the names of above said 18 persons and made entry in the cement distribution register as if cement sold to applicants at concessional rate for the construction of IHHL (Individual Household Latrine) but actually sold cement bags to the cement traders and contractors for Rs.250/- per bags.

Therefore, A-1 to A-4 were colluded with each other and fabricated applications and put the bogus signature and sold 3,740 cement bags to cement traders and contractors. For that they attained wrongful gain of Rs.2,24,400/- (3,740X250=9,35,000) - (3,740X190=7,10,600) (9,35,000-7,10,600=2,24,400) from concessional cement bags and thereby the A-1 to A-4 were committed malpractices in Amma cement supply scheme.

The above information collected during Enquiry, discloses suspicion of commission of cognizable offences u/s 167, 468, 420, 409, 471, 477(A) IPC and u/s 13(1)(a) r/w13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act 2018 by A-1 to A-4.

Hence, a Regular Case in Pudukkottai V&AC Cr.No.08/2020 u/s 167, 468, 420, 409, 471, 477(A) IPC and u/s 13(1)(a) r/w13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act 2018 against A-1 to A-4 is registered by me on 18.11.2020 at 13.00 hrs.

The original FIR is submitted to The Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Special Judge, Pudukkottai and copies forwarded to the concerned higher authorities.
