Kanyakumari Detachment a Nagercoil, received and perused the memorandum of DVAC, Chennai in V.R. No.22548/2020/TP/KK dated 23.07.2021 along with the copy of prior approval u/s 17 (A) (1) of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988, as amended by Act 16 of 2018 with Letter (2D) No. 20 dt 06.05.2021 issued by the competent authority against AO-1 to AO-4 mentioned in accused column the Accused officer No-1 is working as Executive officer, KalluKoottam

Town Panchayat, Kanyakumari District from 02.02.2019 to till date. The Accused Officer No-2 Tr. Selvin George is working as Junior Engineer (Town panchayat), KalluKoottam Town Panchayat, Kanyakumari District from 09.03.2019 to till date. The Accused officer No-3 Tr.Sanal Kumar is working as Assistant Executive Engineer, (Town panchayat), Nagercoil Zone, Nagercoil from 01.03.2019 to till date. The Accused officer No-4 Tr.Kannan was working as Assistant Director of Town panchayats. Kanyakumari District from 23.08.2018 to 03.09.2020. As such the above accused officers 1 to 4 are public servants within the ambit and purview of Sec. 2 (C) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. The 5th accused M/s. Narayanan & Co., Karpadai, Vaigaigudi, Sivagangai, Sivagangai District is a Private individual. There are 55 Town Panchayats in Kanyakumari District. The Director of Town Panchayats is the Head of Town Panchayat Administration at the State level. Accordingly, the Director reviews and monitors the affairs of the Town Panchayats in the State. For convenience of administration, the whole area in the State is divided into 17 zones which are placed in the charge of the Assistant Directors of Town Panchayats. The Assistant Directors of Town Panchayats have to function independently under the supervision and control of the Director of Town Panchayats and they, in their turn, have to keep stern superintendence and control over the administration of the Town Panchayats in their respective zones. The Assistant Directors of Town Panchavats have to ensure that all the activities, especially those relating to the developmental programmes implemented through the Town Panchayats in their zones are carried out properly, promptly and fairly. They are authorized to grant administrative sanction for works not exceeding Rs.20 lakhs in estimate value. On technical matters the Assistant Directors of Town Panchayats are assisted by the Assistant Executive Engineers, who are expected to function under the control of the former. sThe Assistant Executive Engineers are authorized to grant technical sanction for works not exceeding Rs. 20 lakhs in estimate value. The Assistant Directors of Town Panchavats and the Assistant Executive Engineers attached to their offices have authority to inspect important ongoing works. The Assistant Executive Engineers are expected to check measure the measurements recorded by the Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers attached to the Town Panchayats. In addition to this, the Assistant Executive Engineers are expected to verify and counter sign all the documents, particularly the Abstract Bills for payment to the contractors, prepared by the Assistant Engineers / Junior Engineers attached to the Town Panchayats. The Town Panchayats are administered by the Executive Officers who are answerable to the Assistant Directors of Town Panchayats and the superior officers in the hierarchy. The Executive Officers of Town Panchayats are the Executive Authorities of the Town Panchayats. They are authorized to sign all cheques for payments from Panchayat fund and other funds under their control or dominion. At the Town Panchayat level, the Executive Officers are responsible for the implementation of Government Programmes as well as for the other routine functions of the Town Panchayat. Accordingly, it is the responsibility of the Executive Officers to carry out the duly sanctioned works and make payments there for to the contractors concerned by cheques. While discharging such responsibilities the Executive Officers are obliged to strictly adhere to the principles of financial propriety as well as the rules and regulations, department instructions and well-established fundamental principles relating to public procurement. The superior officers concerned also have a duty to ensure that their subordinate officers scrupulously follow such rules and regulations, instructions and principles. During the second half of the financial year 2019-2020, the Kallukoottam Town Panchayat in Kanyakumari District has installed a 9.0 Meter High Mast Lighting Systems with Solar LED Lights at Udaiyarvilai Junction in Kallukoottam Town Panchayat. In that connection, allegations have emerged to the effect that sizeable amount of Panchayat Fund has been misappropriated by the Executive Officer of Kallukoottam Town Panchayat with the connivance and aid of the other officers involved in the affairs, by making procurement of materials and services required for those works at exorbitantly high and

excessive prices from a favoured contractor and also by conveniently violating the rules and regulations, the department instructions and the fundamental principles relating to public procurement and financial propriety. It is ascertained that, a scrutiny of the file and M book relating to the work of supply, Delivery, installation of 9.0 metre High Mast Lighting systems with Solar LED lights at Udayarvilai Junction in Kallukoottam Town panchayat was undertaken and the persons likely to be acquainted with the facts and circumstances of the procurement proceedings were confidentially contacted. The following information came to the light. AO-5 M/s. Narayanan & Co. has commenced the work on 11.03,2020. AO-2 Tr. Selvin George has recorded the measurements relating to this work at pages 1 to 4 of M.Book No. 89/2019-2020 on 11.03,2020. AO-3 Tr.Sanal Kumar has check-measured those measurements on 14.03.2020. The Completion Certificate for this work has been prepared by AO-2 Tr. Selvin George and countersigned by AO-3 Tr.Sanal Kumar on 30.03.2020. The Abstract Bill for payment of Rs. 6,37,126/- to M/s. Narayanan & Co. has been prepared by AO-2 Tr. Selvin George (at pages 5 and 6 of M.Book No. 89/2019-2020) and countersigned by AO-3 Tr.Sanal Kumar on 30.03.2020, AO-1 Tr. Ambrose has passed the bill for the same amount on 16.06.2020 and on the very same day, has issued cheque No.421068 dt. 16.06.2020 for Rs.5,80,012/- in favour of AO-5 M/s. Narayanan This cheque amount of Rs.5,80,012/- represents the net amount & Co. payable to the contractor after subtraction of Rs.57,114/- towards the usual deductions from the bill amount of Rs.6,37,126/- passed for the work. It is ascertained that, the criminal conspiracy among AO-1 to AO-4 to commit and abet one another in the commission of the offences of cheating, criminal breach of trust by public servant, criminal misconduct by public servant and public servant framing incorrect documents with intent to cause injury, AO-1 being a public servant viz Executive Officer of Kallukoottam Town Panchayat and as such public servant, being entrusted with dominion and control over the funds of the said Town panchayat, with the active connivance and aid of AO-2 to AO-4 committed misappropriation, criminal breach of trust and criminal

misconduct in respect of a sum of Rs. 1,51,970/- of the above said Panchayat funds, by dishonestly making procurement of the materials and services for the work of "supply, Delivery, Installation of 9.0 Metre High Mast Lighting Systems with Solar LED lights at Udayarvilai Junction in Kallukoottam Town Panchayat at an exorbitantly high and excessive price of Rs. 5,62,970/- from AO-5, a favoured contractor, when the real prevailing market price of which was just Rs. 4,11,000/- and dishonestly making payment there for at such exorbitantly high and excessive price and also by deliberately violating the rules and regulations, the department instructions and the fundamental principles of public procurement and financial property, with a view to favour AO-5 and to pave the way for such procurement at exorbitantly high and excessive price, AO-2 and AO-3 being public servants viz Junior Engineer (Town Panchayat) and Assistant Executive Engineer (Town Panchayat) respectively and as such public servants being charged with the preparation of estimates, Tender Schedules, M Book measurements, certificates for completion of works, Abstract Bills for payment to contractors, etc. in respect of the works carried out by the Panchayat, abetted AO-1 in the Commission of the aforesaid offences, by preparing such records in respect of this work in a manner which they knew or believed to be incorrect intending thereby to cause injury by way of financial loss to the panchayat and AO-5 abetted AO-1 to AO-4 in the commission of the aforesaid offences by offering tender for this work with exorbitantly high and excessive rates and by receiving the excess amount of Rs. 1,51,970/-. It is learnt through reliable sources that, out of the 55 Town Panchayats in Kanyakumari District nearly 19 Town Panchayats including the Kallukoottam Town panchayat have installed 9.0 Metre High Mast Lighting Systems with Solar LED Lights. Likewise 18 other Town panchayats are namely. 1. Kanyakumari Special Grade Town Panchayat, 2. Kallukoottam Grade-I Town Panchayat, 3. South Thamaraikulam Grade-II Town Panchayat, 4. Suchindrum Selection Grade Town Panchayat, 5. Marungoor Grade-II Town Panchayat, 6. Aralvoimozhy Selection Grade Town Panchayat, 7. Azhagiapandipuram Grade-II Town Panchayat, 8. Mandaikadu Grade-II Town Panchayat, 9. Vellimalai Grade-II Town Panchayat, 10. Manavalakurichi Selection Grade Town Panchayat, 11. Reethapuram Grade-I Town Panchayat, 12. Mulagumoodu Grade-I Town Panchayat, 13. KarungalSelection Grade Town Panchayat, 14. Thiruvattar Grade-I Town Panchayat, 15. Thiruparappu Selection Grade Town Panchayat, 16. Valvatchagostam Grade-I Town Panchayat, 17. Palugal Grade-I Town Panchayat, 18. Verkilambi Grade-I Town Panchayat and 19. Kulasekaram Grade-I TownPanchayat Among the above 19 Town Panchayats, Kanyakumari Selection Grade Town Panchayat has installed 4 numbers of such Lights, Mulagumoodu Grade-I Town Panchayat has installed 2 numbers such lights and each of the remaining 17 Town Panchayats has installed I number of such light. In total, 23 numbers of such lights have been installed by these 19 panchayats in Kanyakumari District. Strangely and in a way arousing strong suspicion, all the 19 Town Panchayats have entrusted this work to AO-5 M/S. Narayanan & Co at the same exorbitant rate of Rs. 5,62,970/- following almost similar methods and Modus Operandi described the above accused and other officials concerned of the above mentioned 18 other panchayats similarly indulged in corruption to be ascertained during the course of investigation. In the very nature of things, it is obvious that all these dishonest activities could not have been successfully accomplished without the connivance of AO-4 Tr.Kannan, the Assistant Director of Town Panchayat, Nagercoil Zone, Nagercoil. His complicity or otherwise could be determined only during regular investigation. The activities of the Suspect Officers seems to be the result of an organized crime having widespread ramifications. The excess amount paid to AO-5 M/S. Narayanan & Co. in respect of installation of one number of such light is Rs. 1,51,970/-. A simple numerical calculation would show that the excess amount paid to AO-5 M/s. Narayanan & Co in respect of installation of 23 numbers of such Lights is Rs. 34,95,310/- (23×1 , 51, 970). The Accused officer – 1 to 4 abused their official position to get pecuniary gain from the AO-5 private individual and thus caused huge loss to the Government. The act of the above accused officers 1 to 4 in collusion with accused No.5 with common intention and mutual

understanding was the result of criminal conspiracy entered among A1 to A-5 between 11.03.2020 to 16.06.2020 to misappropriate the Govt. funds allotted to the erection of High Mast Light in Kallukootam Town panchayat had framed incorrect records, criminal breach of trust for the purpose of cheating the Government funds dishonestly under their dominion and control misappropriated for their own use of such Government funds entrusted to them jointly under their control as public servant and thus committed criminal misconduct and the same discloses prima facie commission of offence and Section 120-B, 167, 409 r/w 109 of IPC and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(a) of the Prevention of Corruption Act 1988, as amended by Act 16/2018. Hence a case In Kanyakumari Detachment at Nagercoil V&AC Cr. No.06/2021 u/s 120-B, 167, 409 r/w 109 of IPC and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(a) of Prevention of Corruption Act 1988, as amended by Act 16/2018 was registered on 06.08.2021 at 12.30 hrs.

I sent the original FIR to the CJM cum Special Judge court, Nagercoil and other copies to the concerned officials and a copy of FIR to the Tmt.C.Siva sankari, Inspector of Police, V&AC, Nagercoil for the purpose of investigation.
