ATTACHMENT TO COLUMN NO. 12 OF THE FIRST INFORMATIN REPORT IN VIGILANCE AND ANTI-CORRUPTION, SALEM DETACHMNET CRIME NO. 13/AC/2021

A Petition was given by Tmt.P.Vijalayakshmi W/o.R.Angamuthu, Head Mistress, Govt. High School, 66/2 R.S. Road, Thoppupalayam Puthur Perunthurai, Erode District on 19.02.2018 along with the suicide note of her husband Tr.Angamuthu A-2 (since deceased), formerly Registrar, Periyar University, Salem against Tr.Swaminathan formerly Vice Chancellor, Periyar University, Salem and other officials working in Periyar University, Salem to the Director, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai with a request to take legal action. Based on that, a Preliminary Enquiry was conducted and on the outcome of the enquiry, this case was registered today 13.08.2021 at 18.00 hrs against the accused persons. The details are given below.

A1 Tr.C.Swaminathan was formerly Vice Chancellor, Periyar University, Salem during the relevant period from 16.6.2014 to 15.6.2017 and now retired from service.

A2 Tr.R.Angamuthu was formerly Registrar, Periyar University, Salem during the relevant period from 18.8.2012 to 17.8.2015 and expired on 18.12.2017.

A3 Tmt.S.Leela was formerly Controller of Examinations, Periyar University, Salem during the relevant period from 17.2.2015 to 16.2.2018 and now retired from service.

It is found that malpractices have been committed in publishing the semester examination results of Periyar University for the years 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 (upto June 2018) revealed that A1 hatched a criminal conspiracy with A3 Tmt.S.Leela, formerly Controller of Examinations, Periyar University with malafide intention of deriving illegal pecuniary gain and committed serious irregularities by awarding contract to one Tr.Aravinth, Proprietor of a private computer centre M/s. K. Lab Chennai for publishing the semester examination results of Periyar University which is highly confidential.

It is found that A1 appointed A3 as Controller of Examinations and hatched a criminal conspiracy with A-3 to derive pecuniary gain with one Tr Aravind, Proprietor of private computer center M/s. K.Labs, Chennai, during the period 2015-2016 to 2018-2019 (May 2018), awarded the contract to the said private firm for the publication of semester examination results of the Periyar University and its affiliated colleges, ranging from Rs. 3/- to Rs.5.25/- per answer sheets to a total sum of Rs.3,26,01,793/-, without obtaining prior permission from the Higher Education Department of the Tamil Nadu Government.

It is found that the Department of Computer Science, Periyar University was having all facilities to publish the semester results. Without utilizing the facility, A1 and A3 deliberately caused loss to the university by taking illegal gratification and misappropriated the university fund.

This process of engaging a private computer centre to deal with the confidential matter of publishing the university results is not at all required for a Government University when all the facilities are very well available within the University. This clearly indicated that A-1 Tr.C.Swaminathan and A-3 Tmt.S.Leela had wantonly indulged in this illegal activity for their illegal personal gain which caused a loss to the funds of university to the tune of Rs.3.26 Crores.

As per the statutes of Periyar University, the Vice Chancellor had the financial power of only Rs.10 Lakhs. If the expenditure is more than Rs.10 Lakhs, the Vice Chancellor should have obtained the approval from the Finance Committee of Higher Education Department. But in this instance, around Rs.50 Lakhs per semester was illegally sanctioned continuously for 6 semesters, totally Rs.3.25 Crores paid to M/s K Labs Chennai by A-1 Tr.C.Swaminathan without obtaining any approval from the Finance Committee of Higher Education Department, Govt. of Tamil Nadu.

Thereby, A1 connived with A3 caused loss to the university to the tune of Rs.3.25 Crores and derived illegal pecuniary gain by fabricating false records, used the

false records as genuine, cheating and deliberately violating the statutes of Periyar University.

It is further found that A1 Tr.C.Swaminathan and A2 Tr.K.Angamuthu (since deceased) have committed irregularities in granting affiliation to the newly started Colleges namely 1) Kavitha College of Arts and Science, Vaiyappamalai, Namakkal District, 2) Sakthi Kailash Women's College, Dharmapuri, 3) Sri Kailash Women's College, Thalaivasal, Salem District, 4) Mysoori Arts and Science College, Kakkapalayam, Salem District, 5) Gandhi College of Arts and Science for Women, Nallur, Namakkal District which revealed that A1 in active connivance with A2 granted affiliations to those Colleges which were not even having the basic infrastructure facilities as per the UGC guidelines at that time, after receiving huge sum of illegal gratification.

It is further found that irregularities have been committed by A1 Tr.C.Swaminathan and A2 Tr.K.Angamuthu (since deceased) in granting affiliation to the newly started courses to the Colleges which were not having adequate infrastructure facilities to run the above said courses. For E.R.K. College of Arts and Science, Erumiampatty Post, Harur Taluk, Dharmapuri District affiliation was granted to five courses 1) B.Com, 2) M.Sc. Chemistry, 3) M.Com, 4) M.Phil (Mathematics), 5) Computer Science during the year 2013-2014 and for four courses 1) B.Sc (Botany), 2) M.A. (Tamil), 3) M.Sc. (Physics), 4) M.Phil (English) during the year 2014-2015. At the time of affiliation provided, this College did not have adequate infrastructure facilities to run the above said courses. Similarly, for Kongunadu Arts and Science College, Mamangam, Salem, the affiliation was granted during the year 2015-2016 for B.Sc. (Physics) and to the Balamurugan College of Arts and Science, Mecheri, Salem District, affiliation was granted during the year 2014-2015 for commencing M.Sc. (Chemistry) and M.Sc. (Physics) and during the year 2015-2016 for commencing M.A. (Tamil).

It is evident that, A1 connived with A2 (deceased) and others, hatched a criminal conspiracy in granting affiliation to the newly started Colleges and granting

affiliation to start new courses to the affiliated Colleges of Periyar University by deliberately violating UGC guidelines during his tenure as Vice Chancellor of Periyar University by abusing his official position after having derived illegal pecuniary gain.

The enquiry conducted with respect to the aforesaid allegations of malpractices disclosed that a prima facie cognizable offence is made out against A1 to A3 u/s 120-B, 409, 420 IPC and u/s 13 (2) r/w 13 (1) (a) (c) & (d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

Hence, I registered a case against A-1 to A-3 in Salem V&AC Cr.No.13/AC/2021 u/s 120-B, 409, 420 IPC and u/s 13 (2) r/w 13 (1) (a) (c) & (d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 on 13.08.2021 at 18.00 hrs. The suitable order was obtained from the competent authority for registration of the case.

The original FIR is submitted to the Hon'ble Special Judge, Special Court for Trial of Cases under Prevention of Corruption Act, Salem District and a copy of the FIR is submitted to the Director, Vigilance & Anti-Corruption, Chennai-16 and the case was entrusted to Tr.R.D.Ravikumar, Inspector of Police, Salem Vigilance and Anti-Corruption for further investigation.
