**CONTINUATION OF THE FIRST INFORMATION REPORT IN  
COIMBATORE V&AC Cr.No.16/2021/AC/CB, DATED. 04.08.2021.**

It is submitted that, an enquiry was conducted against Dr.A.Ganapathi, formerly Vice Chancellor of Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. The enquiry revealed the following informations:

The accused Dr.A.Ganapathi(A1), was working as Vice Chancellor of Bharathiar University, Coimbatore from 03.03.2016 to 06.02.2018. During the period between June 2016 and November 2016, he had initiated steps to recruit Professors, Associate Professors and Assistant Professors for the various departments of the Bharathiar University, Coimbatore in Regular, UGC-XII plan and Constitutional collages. It is revealed that he has intensely committed irregularities and malpractices by violating the UGC norms with the assistance of Scrutiny Committee Members and allowed maximum number of ineligible candidates for appearing interview to extract maximum bribe from the candidates. The said candidates were those who had not even guided/guiding doctoral candidates and also who did not have either enough teaching or research experiences and who did not have minimum "Academic Performance Indicator" as stipulated in the UGC norms. The above accused no 1 acted in the above manner with the intension to extract maximum bribe from the applicants. During the interview, maximum marks were awarded to the bribe givers and suppressed the actual marks of the eligible/efficient applicants in the evaluation sheet with the assistance of "Selection Committee Members" and "Members of Confidential work" with intention to select the bribe givers to become first in the selection list. This was done without conducting test for "Domain knowledge" and "Teaching skill"


and has awarded maximum marks in the head to bribe givers and suppressed the marks of the efficient scholars. When some of the following applicants asked about the selection, the Vice Chancellor Dr.A.Ganapathi demanded Rs.25 lakhs from Dr.N.Ponpandian, who had applied for the post of Professor in the Department of Nanoscience and Technology, and demanded Rs.15 lakhs from Dr.R.Prabhakaran, who had applied for the post of Associate Professor in the Department of Chemistry through the accused Dr.N.Dharmaraj(A2), Professor, Department of Chemistry and demanded Rs.40 lakhs from Dr.T.Vinoth Kumar, who had applied for the post of Associate Professor in the Department of Biotechnology and Microbial Bio-technology through the accused Dr.S.Girija(A3), Associate Professor, Department of Biotechnology and demanded Rs.60 lakhs directly from Dr.R.Ravi, who had applied for the post of Associate Professor in the Department of Extension and Career Guidance and Education and demanded Rs.40 lakhs directly from Dr.Tha.Thayumanavan, who had applied for the post of Assistant Professor in the department of Environmental Sciences and demanded Rs.35 lakhs from Dr.M.Vijayakumar, who had applied for the post of Assistant Professor, Sociology, through the accused Dr.R.Mathivanan(A4), Director, Human Resource Development Centre and demanded Rs.25 lakhs from Dr. S. Arun Meena, who had applied for the post of Assistant Professor, Bioinformatics through the accused Dr.P.Anbalagan(A5), Associate Professor, Physical Education and demanded Rs.35 lakhs from Dr.C.Nilavamuthan, who had applied for the post of Assistant Professor, Bioinformatics through the accused Dr.V.Ramasubramanian(A6), Associate Professor, Department of

Zoology and demanded Rs.25 lakhs from Dr.N.Sri Lakshmi Prabha, who had applied for the post of Assistant Professor, Biotechnology through the accused Dr.Gnanasekaran(A7), Professor and head, Department of Tamil. On knowing the commission of irregularities, malpractices, demand of bribe in the selection, the Government had instructed the Vice Chancellor Dr.A.Ganapathi not to conduct the syndicate meeting which was proposed to be held on 19.11.2016 for approving the above said selection list and also instructed the Vice Chancellor not to conduct further Syndicate meeting without the approval of the Government. The Vice Chancellor did not bother about the instructions of the government, had conducted the Syndicate meeting on 22.11.2016 with only intention to give appointment for the bribe givers and approved the improper selection list and on the same day, the appointment orders were prepared for all the selected candidates and issued to the ineligible candidates and about 75 percentage of the selected candidates, who were already aware about their selection has joined their duty on the same day i.e., 22.11.2016.

Thus, the Vice Chancellor Dr.A.Ganapathi(A1), conspired with his subordinates who were acting as intermediaries, during the period between June 2016 and November 2016 abusing his official possession, committed several irregularities and malpractices and also demanded bribe ranging from 15 lakhs to 60 lakhs from the above said applicants for posting them as Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors for the departments of Bharathiar University, Coimbatore. The Scrutiny Committee Members, Members of Confidential work and Selection Committee Members abetted the A1 to do the aforesaid offences.

Hence, there are prima facie material available for taking investigation against accused A1 Dr.A.Ganapathi for the commission of offences punishable u/s 120(B) IPC and 7,13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. Accused A2) Dr.N.Dharmaraj, A3) Dr.S.Girija, A4) Dr.R.Mathivanan, A5) Dr.P.Anbalagan, A6) Dr.V.Ramasubramanian, A7) Dr.Gnanasekaran committed offences punishable under section 120(B), 109 IPC and 7, 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. And hence, Today 04.08.2021, between 1400 hrs and 1500 hrs, I am registering a case in Coimbatore V&AC crime No.16/2021/AC/CB, 120(B), 109, IPC and 7, 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 against accused A1 to A7 and for the aforesaid offences for the purpose to investigation.

The original FIR is submitted to the Court of the Special Judge, Special court for trial of cases under the Prevention of Corruption Act, Coimbatore and a copy of it is being sent to the Superior officer.
