Submitted: I C.Sivasankari, Inspector of Police, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Kanyakumari Detachment at Nagercoil while on duty on 09.03.2022, I, received the Memorandum from Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai in PE 95/2018/PWD/KK dated 31.01.2022 along with copy of prior approval of Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Public Works Department, Secretariat, Chennai-9 as per letter No.6454/E-1/2021-1, dt.02.11.2021 under section 17(A) (1) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by Act 16/2018, I register the following case against the accused. The factual matrix of the case disclosed through the above mentioned Preliminary Enquiry is narrated as under. The 1st accused

Continuation of FIR in Kanyakumari V&AC Cr.No.02/2022

Tr.A.Christhu Nesakumar was working as Executive Engineer, PWD, Anti Sea Erosion, Kanyakumari District from 14.08.2015 to 25.07.2019.

The 2nd accused Tr.S.Arjunan, was working as an Assistant Executive Engineer, Kothayar Sub-Project, Implementation Sub-Division, Kuzhithurai, Kanyakumari District from 11.03.2017 to 31.03.2018.

The 3rd accused Tr.Thanumoorthy is working as Assistant Engineer, Public Works Department, Sea Erosion Section-I, Thuckalai, Kanyakumari District from 09.08.2017 to till date.

As such the above accused AO-1 to AO-3 are Public Servants within the definition of Section 2(c) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988.

The 4th accused Tr.C.Ramesh son of Tr.S.Chellan is a Contractor by profession and residing at Kallathivilai, Cheramangalam, Manavalakurichi Post, Kanyakumari District, (Private Individual).

Estimate had been prepared for the Rehabilitation of the Rubble Mound sea wall to a extent of 750 meters at Eraviputhenthurai, Sea Shore, Vilavancode Taluk presently Killiyoor Taluk, Kanyakumari District, at an estimated cost of Rs.300 lakhs and G.O.Ms.No.52/Public Works (W1) Dept. at 10.03.2017 has been published in connection with the Administrative Sauction of Government with regard to the above said work. Thereafter, after complying all the due procedure, contract had been awarded to the 4th accused Tr.Ramesh and work had been entrusted to him on 01.11, 2017.

The nature of the said contract work was formation of Armour Layer and doing Armour packings with the help of stones weighing from 1000 to 1500kg from the quarries where the said stones were available.

The said stones shall be loaded in Tipper lorries and would be weighed in the weigh bridge owned by Public Works Department at Poonthurai and shall be unloaded in the work site at Eraviputhenthurai. dumped at the work site confirm that the stones were Eraviputhenthurai, signature has to be obtained in the invoice from the Site Supervisor and again the empty tipper lorry shall be weighed in the weigh bridge at Poonthurai by the Assistant Engineer and necessary entries shall be made in the Trip Register. Thereafter the time of return of the empty Tipper Lorry, the weight of the empty tipper lorry and the total weight of stone brought in the tipper lorry shall be calculated and entered in the trip register and shall be signed by the Assistant Engineer. To ensure the correctness of the above entries in each trip, the Assistant Engineer and the Contractor shall sign in the trip sheet. To confirm the above entries are correct the Assistant Executive Engineer and Executive Engineer have to counter sign in the trip sheet during the time of their Inspection. The huge stones dumped at the work site at Eraviputhenthurai used for armour layer and armour packing in the Rubble Mound Sea Wall, Measurement shall be taken by Assistant Engineer and entered into the M.Books. These measurement would be cross checked and super checked by Assistant Executive Engineer and Executive Engineer and they shall sign in the M Book. The above said measurement and quality of work shall be checked by the Divisional Quality Control Wing to ensure the quality of the work. As per the entries in the M.Book it discloses that Superintendent Engineer, PWD on 14.11.2018 had inspected the worksite and checked the quality of the work and certified and endorsed his signature at the end of M.Book.

The alleged works carried out from 01.11.2017 to 20.01.2018 have been entered in the M.Books 1462^A and 1297^A. According to the alleged measurements entered in the Trip Register and M.Book it discloses that 16482.24 MT stones were dumped at the above said work site from 01.01.2017 to 20.01.2018.

The entries in the M-Book as if that total work to a tune of Rs.2,80,42,534/- have been executed till 31.10.2018 as per the specification in the agreement of contract.

When enquired about the vehicles which were alleged to have been used to bring the stones from Quarries to the work site and their numbers entered in the Trip Register, invoice and M Book, it is ascertained through RTO, Nagercoil that TN-72-C-0797 is not a Lorry and it is Bajaj M-80 two wheeler motor cycle and TN-30-AX-8336 is not a Lorry and it is TATA ACE-LGV four wheeler have a capacity of carrying 745 kg alone in the vehicle.

So, it is clear that the above said officials in collusion with 4th accused fraudulently entered the above said vehicle numbers in the Trip Register, Invoice and M-Book wherein any stones weighing 1000 to 1500 kg cannot be transported in the above said vehicles. The officials had recorded as if 118 MT weighing stones have been brought through the above vehicles TN-72-C-0797 and TN-30-AX-8336. But the said vehicles are M-80 scooter and TATA ACE and as such there is no chance to transport the stones weighing 1000 kg to 1500 kg in the above said vehicles.

The statement of the stone quarry owners discloses that 475.44 MT stones alone had been brought to the work site. On calculation with regard to the claim by the accused that 16482.24 MT stones were

transported to the work site. The actually transported stones as per the statement of quarry owners is 475.44 MT. Now (16482.24M.T minus 475.44 MT= 16006.8 MT). SO 16006.8 MT stones have not been transported for execution of the alleged work to the work site. The value of per MT stone is Rs. 402/-. Accordingly, the cost of the non-transported 16006.8 MT stones multiplied by Rs. 402/- Per MT accrues to Rs. 64,34,733/-. This amount had been misappropriated by the accused without actually executing the work as per estimate.

So, it is crystal clear that they had not transported the said 16006.8 MT weighing stones to the work site but they have fraudulently recorded as they brought these stones to the work site through the vehicles and misappropriated the amount of Rs. 64,34,733/- and caused loss to the Government to the said extent.

The Accused Officer 1 to 3 were responsible for execution of the above said work as per the specification mentioned in the contract and agreement along with 4th accused.

Presently, a Preliminary Enquiry had been conducted from 01.11.2017 to 20.01.2018 and the above said loss had been unearthed. To unearth the loss from 21.01.2018 to 31.10.2018, the period of execution as claimed by the accused has to be unearthed and the actual loss in total and other officials if any involved in this scam has to be done by conducting further investigation in this case.

Thus the AO-1 to AO-3 being public servants and A4 have entered into criminal conspiracy from 01.11.2017 to 31.10.2018 with common intention of misappropriating the funds allocated to execute the above work and in pursuance of the same, have framed incorrect Trip register, Invoice and M Book by making false entries and committed criminal

breach of Trust in respect of property under their control and dominion and criminal misconduct, and converted the funds for their own use in respect of the funds entrusted to them and under their control as public servants or allows any other person so to do it for the purpose of misappropriation.

Therefore, today 09.03.2022 at 14.00 hrs I am registering the case in Kanyakumari Detachment Vigilance and Anti-Corruption Cr.No.2/2022 against A-1 Tr.A. Christhu NesaKumar, Formerly EE, PWD/Anti- Sea Erosion Division, Kanyakumari District. A-2 Tr.S. Arjunan, Formerly AEE, PWD/Anti- Sea Erosion Division, Kanyakumari District. A-3 Tr. M. Thanumoorthy, Formerly AE, PWD/Anti- Sea Erosion Division, Kanyakumari District and A-4 Tr.C. Ramesh, Contractor (Private Individual) for the commission of offences 13(2) r/w 13(1)(c) of PC Act 1988 and 13(2) r/w 13(1)(a) of PC Act 1988 (as amended by Act 16/2018) and 120-B, 167, 409,477-A, 34 of IPC.

The original FIR is submitted to the Hon'ble Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Special Judge, Special Court for Trial of cases under Prevention of Corruption Act, Kanyakumari District @ Nagercoil and other copies to the officials concerned and I handed over a copy of the F.I.R to Tmt.T.T.Runa, Inspector of Police for further investigation.
