Contents in Column No.12 of FIR:

Based on the petition of Thiru.Ramu @ R.Ramesh a Preliminary Enquiry was registered in PE.181/2018/EB/CC-I on 25.06.2018. The petitioner Thiru.Ramu @ R.Ramesh residing at his ancestral property situated at Door No.514, Village High Road, Sholinganallur, Chennai in the past 50 years. He has 24 EB connections in his residential house and has rented 20 portions. In 2007, Thiru.R.Ramesh had transferred the name of said ancestral property from his name to his wife Tmt.R.Saraswathi vide Doc.No.4926/2007, dated on 11.09.2007 registered in Neelankarai SRO. Hence he decided to change, the 24 EB connections from his name to his wife Tmt.R.Saraswathi.

- 2. In this regard, the petitioner Thiru.R.Ramesh has approached the office of the Assistant Engineer, Operation & Maintenance, Sholinganallur, North, TANGEDCO, Chennai in the 1st week of April, 2018 for the EB connection name transfer. At that time he met the staff of the same office Thiru.K.Sankar, Commercial Inspector, and Thiru.E.Ramasamy, Commercial Assistant, asked about the name transfer and new service connections. After that they told the petitioner to go and meet Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, Assistant Engineer, O & M, Sholinganallur, North in this regard. Subsequently he met Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, Assistant Engineer, Sholinganallur, North regarding the EB Connections name transfer and new service connections. Thiru.G.Senthilnathan is the then AE Sholinganallur, North and is a public servant as defined u/s 2 (c) of PC Act. Then Thiru.G.Senthilnathan asked the details to the petitioner regarding EB connections which were already existing in his residential house.
- 3. At that time, Thiru.G.Senthilnathan had demanded bribe of Rs.2,500/- for each name transfer and Rs.6,500/- for new service connection apart from the Government fee. The prescribed fee by TANGEDCO is Rs.200/- for a name transfer and Rs.1,600/- for a new service EB connection. Hence the petitioner decided that it was not possible to pay so much money as bribe for the EB connection name transfer. Accordingly he decided that 5 EB connections can be changed from his name to his wife

Tmt.R.Saraswathi. Then he received five name transfer applications and five new service connection applications from Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, AE.

- 4. On 11.04.2018, the petitioner Thiru.R.Ramesh has submitted all the applications along with relevant documents for each five name transfer and each five new service connections to Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, AE, with the signatures of himself and his wife Tmt.R.Saraswathi. At that time, the petitioner paid a legal fee Rs.1,000/for the five name transfers to the AE Thiru.G.Senthilnathan. The petitioner also paid a sum of Rs.5,000/- as bribe as demanded by him and the same was accepted by the AE Thiru.G.Senthilnathan. Subsequently he gave five receipts for the legal fee of five name transfers to the petitioner.
- 5. On the same occasion, the petitioner also paid the legal fee sum of Rs.8,000/-to Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, AE for the five new service connections. Even though Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, AE did not give receipts for this but kept it pending as the petitioner did not give the bribe him for new service connection.
- 6. On 12.04.2018, Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, AE has changed the name of five EB connections from the petitioner to Tmt.R.Saraswathi vide the Registration Nos. 3270418317 to 3270418321 respectively. But the AE was not effecting the new service connections for remaining Rs.2,500/- for name transfer and Rs.6,500/- for new service connections as his earlier demand.
- 7. Thereafter, whenever the petitioner met the accused, the petitioner to give the remaining bribe amount of Rs.2,500/- out of Rs.7,500/- for the name transfer. In order to get the new service connections, the petitioner Thiru.R.Ramesh decided to send his son Thiru.R.Mahadevan, for paying the remaining bribe amount of Rs.2,500/- to Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, AE. On 29.05.2018, Thiru. R.Mahadevan, who is the son of the petitioner met Thiru.G.Senthilnathan at his office. The AE Thiru.G.Senthilnathan reiterated his earlier demand and accepted the remaining amount Rs.2,500/- from the

petitioner's son Thiru.R.Mahadevan at his office. His son recorded the video footage on his mobile phone. The video footage clearly shows that the AE, has accepted a sum of Rs.2,500/- from Tr.R.Mahadevan for effecting name transfer of service connections of the petitioner. Then, the petitioner sent petition to TANGEDCO for taking action against the AE for the demand and acceptance of money along with video footage.

- 8. Subsequently on 13.06.2018, the AE Thiru.G.Senthilnathan sanctioned the five new service connections in favour of the petitioner. According the petitioner Thiru.Ramu @ R.Ramesh has received the receipts for the legal fee of Rs.1600/- for the five new service connections from the AE Thiru.G.Senthilnathan vide Registration Nos. 3270618568 to 3270618572 respectively. The accused by corrupt and illegal means demanded and received bribe to do his official act.
- 9. The above acts reveals cognizable offences by the accused Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, formerly Assistant Engineer, Operation and Maintenance, Sholinganallur, North, TANGEDCO, Chennai.
- 10. Hence I am registering a case in Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, CC-I Detachment Cr.No.4/AC/2022/CC-I, u/s 7 and 13(2) r/w 13 (1) (d) of Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 at 1500 hrs today on 09.03.2022 against the accused Thiru.G.Senthilnathan, Assistant Engineer, TANGEDCO, Sholinganallur, North, Chennai.

The original FIR is submitted to the Honorable Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Special Judge for the Cases under Prevention of Corruption Act, Chengalpet and a copy of it is going to be sent to the Superintendent of Police, Chennai City Range, Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai.
