During the course of collection of vigilance intelligence by the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, the marginally noted A-1 Tr.S.Ravichandran, (Group-A), Director (Operation), TANTRANSCO, Chennai, retired on 29.02.2020, formerly Chief Engineer, System Operation, TANTRANSCO, Chennai had committed irregularities of making payment of an estimated amount of Rs.23,47,000/- and Rs.22,93,000/- said to have been awarded to two private contractors i.e., M/s.Power Tranz Enterprises, Salem and M/s.Jeevan Enterprises, Chennai for Civil and Electrical works of Rs.46,40,000/- for rectification works in two fault locations for which cable wires were damaged by manmade fault at fault locations on 230 KV feeders at the stretch of Kadapperi-CMRL and Taramani-R.A.Puram reported on 13.12.2016 and 30.04.2017 respectively at 2 locations near Parvathy Hospital and Kotturpuram Railway Station. Further, an estimated cost of Rs.30 Lakhs to Rs.60 Lakhs in each case, found to be awarded to the same two private persons. Thus A-1 had caused a wrongful loss to the Exchequer and wrongful gain for himself.

The marginally noted accused officer, while serving as Chief Engineer, System Operation, TANTRANSCO, Chennai, with his subordinate officers had processed the sanction of fault location works and rectification work which were said to have been completed on 17.12.2016 and 08.06.2017 for which, an estimate amount of Rs.23,47,000/- and Rs.22,93,000/- were said to have been awarded to two private contractors i.e., M/s.Power Tranz Enterprises, Salem and M/s.Jeevan Enterprises, Chennai for Civil and Electrical works without following the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act, 1998. It is pertinent to note that in the general conditions of contract on laying 230 KV cables, no repairs or replacement shall normally be carried out by the purchaser or Engineer.

During the Guarantee period (i.e. 36 months for Kadapperi-CMRL and 60 months for Taramani-R.A.Puram after handing over to purchaser), any claim found defective shall be supplied at free of cost by the manufacturer i.e. M/s.Cable Corporation of India (M/s.CCI).

Whereas, the defective manufacturer faults on the above mentioned two places of 230 KV feeder cables rectification work had been carried out by the officials of CDC-I Division, Guindy of TANTRANSCO and the estimate award of work to private enterprises who are not supposed to be allotted since the fault had to be attended at free of cost by M/s.CCI in the above said 230 KV cables replacement work.

By not following the terms and conditions as per specification laid down in the laying of 230 KV cables, A-1 with his subordinate officials had violated the Rules and tender procedures as per Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tenders Act and Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tender Rules, 2000, had awarded the estimate and paved the way for making payment to the

volume of Rs.23,47,000/- and Rs.22,93,000/- for the above mentioned 2 fault rectification works in 2 fault locations to the benefit of private enterprises who were not awarded the work. Even followed by the above said two rectification works on 230 KV cables, five more fault locations were reported in 230 KV feeder in various other locations for which cables were damaged by manmade fault and were also learnt to have been estimated to the cost of Rs.30 Lakhs to Rs.60 Lakhs in each cases and all the works were found to have been awarded to the same private enterprises without following the Tender Transparency Act and terms and conditions of specifications laid down in 230 KV cable laid and thereby caused wrongful loss to the exchequer and wrongful gain for himself.

As per the above facts and circumstances, a prima-facie case is clearly made out on the irregularities committed by A-1 for the estimate, award, execution and payment to in-eligible private enterprises by the CDC-I TANTRANSCO department headed by A-1.

A-1 Tr.S.Ravichandran, formerly Chief Engineer (Grid Operation) and promoted as Director (Operation), TANTRANSCO, Chennai is now retired and a public Servant u/s 2(c) (1) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988. During the period of his service as Chief Engineer System operations, TANTRANSCO Department (Tamil Nadu Transmission Corporation Limited) of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, he had committed the offenses and liable to be punishable under PC Act.

Hence, I register a case against Tr.S.Ravichandran, Formerly Chief Engineer, TANTRANSCO, Grid Operation, Chennai and promoted as Director (Operation) u/s 13(2) r/w 13(1) (c)(d) of Prevention of Corruption Act 2018 on 14.07.2023 at 15.30 hrs in Cr.No.4/AC/2023/CC-II. The original FIR is sent to the Hon'ble Special Court for trial of cases under Prevention of Corruption Act, Chennai and the copy of the FIR is forwarded to the Superior Officers for further action.
