

During the collection of information and Preliminary Enquiry the following information was gathered against Tr. M.Prabu, Panchayat Secretary, formerly Sevoor Panchayat, Katpadi Panchayat Union, Vellore District and his wife Tmt. Kalaiyarasi, into the allegation of accumulation of assets disproportionate to his known sources of income during the period between 01.04.2011 to 31.05.2017 while holding office as public servant.

Tr. M.Prabu, hails from a middle class family. His father Tr. Mani worked as labourer in tannery and engaged in cattle selling business. The AO, entered into the service on 1.04.1997 as part time writer in panchayat office. His mother, Tmt. Indirani, is a house wife. on 08.12.2008 Tr. M.Prabu, married to Tmt. Kalaiyarasi, they were blessed with one daughter and one son namely 1) Shree Nisha and 2) Sandeep, they

are in School studies. Tr. M.Prabu is the only earning member of the family. At present, he is residing at No.22/25, (17/A) Old Colony, Mettupalayam Village, Thiruvalam Post, Katpadi Taluk, Vellore District.

Tr. M.Prabu, was appointed as Part Time Clerk on 01.04.1997 at Kuppathamottur Panchayat by passing resolution in the panchayat. Further, he was promoted as Panchayat Secretary in the year 2011 vide GO (MS) No.52 Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Department dated 29.08.2011 and posted as Panchayat Secretary in Brammapuram Panchyat, Vellore District on 06.06.2012 and served up to 28.02.2013. Later on he was transferred to Kugaiyanallur Panchayat and

worked there from 01.03.2013 to 01.06.2018, subsequently transferred to Sevoor Panchayat Office as Panchayat Secretary. Now, he is working as Panchayat Secretary in Balakuppam Panchayat, Katpadi Panchayat Union, Vellore District. Thereby, he is a Public Servant within the context of Sec. 2 (c) (i) of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 during the above said period.

There is information that the accused Tr. M.Prabu while serving as the Part time clerk till 05.06.2012 and Panchayat Secretary since 06.06.2012 during his office as public servant between April 2011 and May 2017, acquired and was in possession of pecuniary resources and properties in his name and in the name of his wife Tmt. Kalaiyarasi, which is disproportionate to his known sources of income. Based on this information, a Preliminary Enquiry was conducted which disclosed the following information.

For the purpose of quantifying the disproportionate assets acquired by the accused Tr. M.Prabu, the tentative check period was chosen from 01.04.2011 to 31.05.2017. Value of the assets found in his name and his dependents as on 01.04.2011 have been shown under Statement-I. Value of the assets acquired by the accused Tr. M.Prabu in his name and in the name his dependents at the end of check period as on 31.05.2017 have been shown under Statement-II. The income derived by the accused Tr. M.Prabu and his dependents through known sources of income during the check period have been shown under Statement-III and the expenditure incurred by the accused Tr. M.Prabu and his dependents during the check period have been shown under Statement-IV, which are described hereunder.

Statement-I	Assets found in the name of the accused A-1 Tr. M.Prabu and in the name his wife A-2 Tmt. Kalaiyarasi and dependents as on 01.04.2011 i.e., at the beginning of check period (in the form of cash balance at various Banks, house site etc.,)	Rs.3,22,320/-
Statement-II	Assets found in the name of accused A-1 Tr.M.Prabu and in the name his wife A-2 Tmt. Kalaiyarasi and dependents as on 31.05.2017 i.e at the end of check period (in the form of Cash at various Banks, motor vehicle, house sites etc.,)	Rs.24,63,213/-

Statement-III	Income derived by the accused A-1 Tr. M.Prabu during the check period between 01.04.2011 and 31.05.2017 (in the form of salary from the Government, Loans from banks and interest from banks etc.,)	Rs.5,70,460/-
Statement-IV	Expenses incurred by the accused A-1 Tr. M.Prabu and his wife A-2 Tmt. P.Kalaiyarasi and dependents during the check period between 01.04.2011 and 31.05.2017 (in the form of house hold expenses, stamp duty & registration charges, repayment of loans, interest on loans and processing fee etc.,)	Rs.4,73,250/-

From the above statements, during the check period between 01.04.2011 and 31.05.2017, the value of assets acquired and possessed by the accused Tr. M.Prabu and his dependents have been calculated under Statement-V. The likely savings of the accused Tr. M.Prabu and his dependents have been shown under Statement-VI and the quantum of disproportionate assets acquired by him in his name and in the name of his dependents have been shown under Statement-VII as detailed below.

Statement–V (St.II – St.I)	Assets acquired during the check period from 01.04.2011 to 31.05.2017	Rs. 21,40,893/-
Statement–VI (St.III – St.IV)	Likely savings during the check period between 01.04.2011 to 31.05.2017	Rs. 97,210/-
Statement-VII (St.V - St.VI)	Quantum of Disproportionate assets	Rs. 20,43,683/-

The above figure clearly shows that the accused Tr. M.Prabu, could have saved about Rs.97,210/- during the check period i.e., between 01.04.2011 and 31.05.2017 which is the likely savings and he could have acquired pecuniary resources and properties not exceeding Rs.97,210/- during the check period but he has acquired assets worth Rs.20,43,683/- in excess of his savings. The movable, immovable properties and bank balance during the check period were taken into account for arriving at the quantum of disproportionate assets against him.

The available information and Preliminary Enquiry makes out a prima facie case against A-1 Tr. M.Prabu that he was found in possession of pecuniary resources and properties to the tune of Rs.20,43,683/- in excess to his known sources of income during the check period and the percentage of disproportionate assets works out to 358% more than his income.

Thereby A-1 Tr. M.Prabu, during the check period between 01.04.2011 and 31.05.2017 was found in possession of pecuniary resources and properties in his name and in the name of his wife Tmt. Karaiyarasi, which is disproportionate to his known sources of income and also intentionally enriched himself illicitly during the period of his office, which constituted the offence of Criminal Misconduct and A-2 Tmt. P.Kalaiyarasi, had abetted A-1 to commit the said offence by acquiring the assets through the resources of A-1

Therefore, I register a case in Vellore V&AC Cr.No.03/2024 u/s 13 (2) r/w 13 (1) (e) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 against A-1 Tr. M.Prabu, Panchayat Secretary and punishable u/s.109 IPC r/w 13 (2) r/w 13 (1) (e) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 against A-2 Tmt. P.Kalaiyarasi, on 24.04.2024 at 15.00 hrs.

The original FIR is submitted to the Hon'ble Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate and Special Judge, Vellore, Vellore District and a copy of FIR is sent to the Superintendent of Police, Vigilance and Anti Corruption, North Range, DVAC, Chennai for issuing order u/s 17 of Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 to investigate the case and authorization u/s 18 of the said Act to inspect bankers books in relation to the accounts of the accused and other suspected persons in the case.
