PRESS NOTE

FORMER ASSISTANT INSPECTOR OF LABOUR CONVICTED IN BRIBE CASE

The complaint Tr.M.Muthuramalingam, S/o.Muthusamy Nadar, residing at No.69, West Car Street, Tiruchendur, Thoothukudi District. The complainant running two rice mills at Thoothukudi. The complainant applied for packaged commodities registration certificate. Tr.G.Kaliraj, Formerly Assistant Inspector of Labour, demanded illegal gratification of Rs.3000/- from him for issuance of registration certificate of Packaged commodities for two rice mills(Rs.1500/- each). The complainant not willing to give bribe, preferred complaint with Vigilance and Anti- Corruption, Thoothukudi Detachment. In this connection a trap was organized. On 21.03.2013 Tr.G.Kaliraj, formerly Assistant Inspector of Labour, received the bribe amount from the complainant and was arrested. On completion of investigation, the case was charge sheeted against the accused on 14.05.2014 before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Special Judge, Thoothukudi.

Today (06.01.2025), the accused Tr.G.Kaliraj was convicted to undergo R.I for 3 years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- for the offence u/s 7 of P.C Act and R.I for 3 years and to pay a fine of Rs.5,000/- for the offence u/s 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of P.C Act, I/d 3 months S.I and ordered to undergo both the punishments concurrently by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Thoothukudi.
