FORMER SUB-INSPECTOR OF POLICE CONVICTED IN BRIBE CASE

The complainant Tr.J.Selvarajan, Private Building Contractor, Velachery had business transaction with one Tr. Alagesan. Tr.Alagesan had threatened the complainant regarding financial transaction. Hence, the complainant preferred a complaint to Tmt. Kalaiselvi, Sub-Inspector of Police, Velachery Police Station. Tmt. Kalaiselvi, Formerly Sub-Inspector of Police, demanded bribe of Rs.2000/- from the complainant for settling the issue amicably that arose between the complainant and Tr.Alagesan. The complainant not willing to give bribe, preferred complaint with Vigilance and Anti- Corruption, Chennai Detachment. In this connection a trap was organized. On 11.11.2013 Tmt. Kalaiselvi, Formerly Sub-Inspector of Police, received the bribe amount from the complainant and was arrested. On completion of investigation, the case was charge sheeted against the accused before the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Special Judge, Chennai. Today (21.01.2025), the accused Tmt. Kalaiselvi was convicted to undergo R.I for 4 years and to pay a fine of Rs.50,000/- for the offence u/s 7 of P.C Act and R.I for 5 years and to pay a fine of Rs.50,000/- for the offence u/s 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of P.C Act and ordered to undergo both the punishments concurrently by the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chennai.
