SUB-INSPECTOR OF POLICE CONVICTED IN BRIBE CASE

The complainant Tr. Sourirajan, residing at Kancheepuram District was caught for two wheeler over speed. In this regard Tr. Thangaraj, Sub-Inspector of Police, Traffic, Kancheepuram District seized his original documents and demanded Rs.2,000/- as bribe for not registering a case. The complainant not willing to give bribe, with preferred complaint Vigilance and Anti-Corruption. Kancheepuram Detachment. In this connection a trap was organized. On 26.11.2009 Tr. Thangaraj, Sub-Inspector of Police, Traffic, received the bribe amount from the complainant and was arrested. On completion of investigation, the case was charge sheeted against the The case was tried before the Hon'ble Chief Judicial accused. Magistrate Cum Special Judge, Kancheepuram. Today 21.02.2025 Chief Judicial Magistrate Court Cum Special Court, Kancheepuram pronounced the judgment against Tr. Thangaraj, Sub-Inspector of Police, Traffic and sentenced him to undergo Rigorous Imprisonment for 2 years and to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- u/s.7 of PC Act, 1988 and 3 years and Rs.10,000 for u/s.13(2) r/w 13(1) (d) of the PC Act, 1988, ordered to run the sentence concurrently.
