TALUK OFFICE RECORD CLERK, KARUR DISTRICT CONVICTED FOR 3 YEARS FOR DEMAND AND RECEIVING BRIBE FOR ISSUING LEGAL HEIR CERTIFICATE

In the year 2010 the complainant had applied for Legal Heir Certificate at Kulithalai Taluk office, Karur District, for which Tr.M.Chandrasekar, formerly Record Clerk Kulithalai Taluk Office, Karur District, demanded Rs.500/- as bribe for processing his application. Complainant not willing to give bribe money, approached Vigilance & Anti – Corruption, Karur Detachment, and gave complaint against Tr.M.Chandrasekar. In this connection a case was registered and a trap was organized by Vigilance & Anti – Corruption, Trichy Detachment. During trap proceedings, Tr.M.Chandrasekar, Record Clerk, received the bribe money of Rs.500/- from the complainant and he was arrested by V&AC Trichy detachment. Today 23.02.2023, the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Special Judge, Karur, convicted the accused Tr.M.Chandrasekar, formerly Record Clerk, concerned in Trichy Detachment, V&AC trap case in 2010, to undergo 2 Years Rigorous imprisonment for sec.7 of the PC Act, 1988 and fined Rs.10,000/- and 3 years Rigorous Imprisonment for sec.13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of the PC Act,1988 and fined Rs.10,000/- The sentences were ordered to run concurrently.
